- 3. **Designing customised solutions** provide all-in-one contracts including financing, insurance, servicing, maintenance, and guaranteed battery performance.
- 4. **Implementation and operation support** coordinate all parties, including charging partners, and monitor fleet operations via the Renault Trucks network.
