Chargepoly expands its workforce to support strong growth

Chargepoly, the specialist in ultra-rapid electric charging solutions, has welcomed eleven new employees over the past four months. A further ten positions are currently open, with the company aiming to build a team of one hundred talents by 2027.

Chargepoly is hiring. Based in Aix-en-Provence, the French clean-tech scale-up is actively recruiting to support its rapid development in the design and installation of ultra-rapid EV charging stations for the transport and logistics sectors.

Following a €15 million fundraising round announced last October, Chargepoly has strengthened its teams with new software and product engineers to enhance its charging stations, project engineers to deploy them, and sales engineers to develop a national presence from the South of France to the Paris region. Three additional hires are expected in early March, bringing the workforce to thirty-two, compared with just over twenty only four months ago.

Ten vacancies open now

Continuing this growth trajectory, Chargepoly is seeking a wide range of profiles, including software developers, business managers, technical support engineers and product engineers. Candidates with proven professional experience, ideally in EVSE (Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment), are particularly encouraged to apply.

Committed to **gender equality and equal opportunities in the workplace**, Chargepoly signed the French Tech Parity Pact earlier this year. The company also promotes its attractive working environment as a key asset to attract young talent: a modern office in the heart of the Aix-en-Provence Environmental Technology Park, ranked the world's 4th leading CleanTech hub, flexible working options, career progression opportunities, and a strong focus on work-life balance. In total, Chargepoly plans to recruit around one hundred people over the next four years.

The company has also signed a framework agreement with a global supply chain leader to equip its European depots. Chargepoly is now targeting further expansion in **Europe and North America**.

Recognised in 2022 at the CES in Las Vegas with an award in the "Mobility" category and finalist of the French IP awards (INPI), Chargepoly works in partnership with Vedecom Institute, Sprint Project and AVERE France.

Headquartered at the Environmental Technology Park in Aix-en-Provence, Chargepoly currently employs over twenty engineers and sales professionals in France and in Seattle, USA.
